As one of the first independent schools in the country to offer vocational BTEC qualifications, we have demonstrated a forward-thinking approach to best support our students. Others fast-track their courses, completing GCSEs over one year or studying AS subjects in Key Stage 4.

Outside the classroom, students are challenged to achieve their full potential through successful participation in a range of competitions and events, such as Poetry from the Heart, Mathematics Challenges, BEBRAS Computational Thinking and STEM challenges, such as Race to the Line. Our future medics take part in dissection-based surgery when we host Operating Theatre Live. The ability for older and younger students to work together is immensely rewarding, such as where our Year 12 Business students run an upcycling enterprise event for all of Year 7, or where our Young Enterprise team, consisting of 4 year groups, achieve success as the 'best overall business' in the area round, and 'most sustainable company' in the regional competition. Student collaboration is never more apparent than when older students take on Peer Mentor roles or work together on the Prefect Team.

Our Performance Sports Programme gives students access to top level coaching and bespoke nutrition and strength and conditioning sessions. Graduates from the programme have representedTeam GB in athletics, obtained basketball and soccer scholarships to US universities or gone on to play professional rugby, while our netball team hold the National Schools Competition title. In the creative arts we host three large scale productions each year, with this year's Beauty and the Beast featuring a cast and crew of 65 students. One of the highlights of our school year is the Gym and Dance display, currently in its 10th year, and including over 200 performers.

We run an extensive co-curricular programme of over 100 weekly activities and 445 annual trips. Residentials have included a STEM trip to Texas, a CCF expedition to Gibraltar, a walking challenge in the Netherlands or a charity project in Zambia. From these, and all of the above opportunities, a QE student develops into an independent, resilient, respectful and caring young adult, ready to take their place in the global community.
